Setting up your e-mail account on iPhone:

- 1. Tap Mail or go to Settings -> Mail, Contacts, Calendars -> Accounts and choose Add Account
- 2. Choose "Other"
- 3. Select "Add Mail Account"
- 4. Enter your e-mail settings and select "save" to continue

Name: enter your name

Address: enter your e-mail address Password: enter your password

Description: enter a name for this account - usually same as your e-mail address

When ready select "save".

On the next screen enter your mail server settings, including the following:

Incoming Mail Server

Host Name: mail.lonex.com

User Name: enter your e-mail address

Password: enter the password for this mailbox

Outgoing Mail Server SMTP: mail.lonex.com

User Name: enter your e-mail address

Password: enter the password for this mailbox

Tap "save" to save the entered information. Your iPhone will then verify your account information.

A message may appear to notify you that the server does not support SSL and offer you to use non-SSL connection - agree to that as your mail server does not

support SSL connection.

Once the account has been created, enter it's settings and click on the Outgoing Mail Server - SMTP mail.lonex.com, then Primary Server mail.lonex.com and make sure that the Authentication has been set to "MD5 Challenge-Response" and enter the email account's Username and Password if needed.
